

# St John's Church, Ranmoor

Our Guidance here at St John's is to continue to keep everyone safe. Our guidance is as follows:

- Please use sanitiser on entry and exit to the Church and respect people's personal space.
- Face masks are not required however please feel free to wear one if you feel more comfortable
- Communion will take place with bread only. Please sanitise your hands before receiving Communion.
- The Communion rail will be used to kneel. If you do not wish to come for Communion please speak to a sidesperson who will alert the clergy.
- All social distancing has been removed. But we ask that you respect others space. The side aisles tend to be quieter if you prefer more space.
- Coffee is served at the end of the service. Please respect each others space.
- Clinically extremely vulnerable (CVE) – if you are CVE you are no longer advised to shield, however you should continue to follow government guidance.
- Toilets are available for use
- Track and trace – we will no longer keep your details if you have attended, however you can use the NHS track and trace QR code if you would like to and this will be displayed at the entrance to the church.
- The church will continue to be cleaned and sanitised regularly.
- If you feel unwell – please stay at home and join our services on Facebook live.
