

## **Youth leader for Fair Share group at St John's Ranmoor**

We are recruiting a leader for this youth group which ran successfully from 2011-2014 when the leader retired. It is now reforming and we seek a paid leader who enjoys the company of young people and has a vision of how the gospel of Christ to the poor and vulnerable can be acted out here in Sheffield and in the wider world.

### **Session structure**

- The group will meet fortnightly on Sunday evenings between 18<sup>th</sup> February and the 1<sup>st</sup> July, with breaks for public holidays
- It will run from 7.30-9 pm
- There will be nine sessions this season.

We meet in the Parish Centre Annexe behind Ranmoor Parish Centre just off the Fulwood Rd. This welcoming space for young people has room for large and small group work. Two projects are in place, one with Sheffield Cathedral's Archer Project for the homeless and one with Christian Aid but the third will be planned by our new leader and the group itself.

### **The team**

The leader has a team of three supporters, all experienced in a wide range of project management roles, all DBS checked, all with good links with the congregation of St John's and who all enjoy working with young people. The church will organise and pay for a DBS check for the youth leader. We have established links with the University Chaplaincies and local churches. Members of St John's are involved with humanitarian projects across the city of Sheffield and are a rich source of support.

### **Terms of the contract**

The freelance contract will initially run from February to July 2018. Each two hour session will have an additional weekly two hours of preparation paid for. The rate of pay is £9 an hour. This would be a payment of £360 for the spring and summer seasons with the option of extending the contract for the autumn and winter period. The leader will have access to regular support and an open reference at the end of the spring to summer period. Pizza for each session and leader's expenses will be paid for by the church.
