- On entry and exit please sanitise your hands with the sanitizing gel provided

- Please use the entry and exit system. Entry through the main door and exit through the assisted access door. Walk back around the footpath to the front of the church to exit.
- Please follow the one way system. Enter following the arrows up the central aisle and exit through the side aisles
- Please follow all direction from the Wardens or direction markers and signs
- Available seats are marked with a green card. If you are unsure where to sit
 please ask a sides person
- Please sit in your family groups and keep 2m apart from others.
- Though hymns will sometimes form part of the worship, we are <u>not</u> allowed to sing whilst in church
- Communion will sometimes be part of the worship. Clergy will give instructions about distribution
- The hearing loop will be on but the sound system will not be in use
- Cushions and kneelers will not be available. If you need to use one, please bring your own.
- No hymn books or Bibles will be available. Service Sheets and Notice Sheets will be available. Please take these home with you or use the recycle bin at the back of church
- The toilets, Coffee area and Children's area are all out of bounds
- Our services are broadcast live on ZOOM and YouTube
- Please respect each others personal space.
- Please stay at home if you feel unwell or have been in contact with someone who is ill.
- Those medically shielding or the over 70s to be encouraged to stay at home.
