

Welcome to St John's Church, Ranmoor

Please follow these updated guidelines to keep everyone safe:

- ◆ On entry and exit please sanitise your hands with the **sanitizing foam** provided
- ◆ **Test and Trace**—we have to collect names and contact numbers of everyone entering the building. Sidespeople will ask you this when you come in—we also have the QR code which works alongside the Test and Trace App
- ◆ **Please use the ONE WAY entry and exit system.** Entry through the main door and exit through the assisted access door. Walk back around the footpath to the front of the church to exit.
- ◆ **Please follow the one way system.** Enter following the arrows up the central aisle and exit through the side aisles
- ◆ Please follow direction from the Wardens, sidespeople or **direction markers and signs**
- ◆ Available seats are marked with a **green card**. If you are unsure where to sit please ask a sides person
- ◆ Please sit in your **family groups** and keep 2m apart from others.
- ◆ Hymns will sometimes form part of the worship, we are not allowed to sing whilst in church.
- ◆ **Communion** will sometimes be part of the worship. Clergy will give instructions about distribution
- ◆ **Cushions and kneelers** will not be available. If you need to use one, please bring your own. **No hymn books or Bibles** will be available. **Service Sheets and Notice Sheets** will be available. Please take these home with you or use the recycle bin at the back of church
- ◆ **The toilets, Coffee area and Children's area** are all out of use
- ◆ Our services are **broadcast live on ZOOM and Facebook live**
- ◆ Please respect each others personal space.
- ◆ Please **stay at home** if you feel unwell or have been in contact with someone who is ill.
- ◆ Those medically shielding or the over 70s to be encouraged to stay at home.
- ◆ **At the end of the Church Service please leave promptly.** Gathering of people at the end of church services to chat and catch with each other is not permitted.
