Second Sunday of Lent

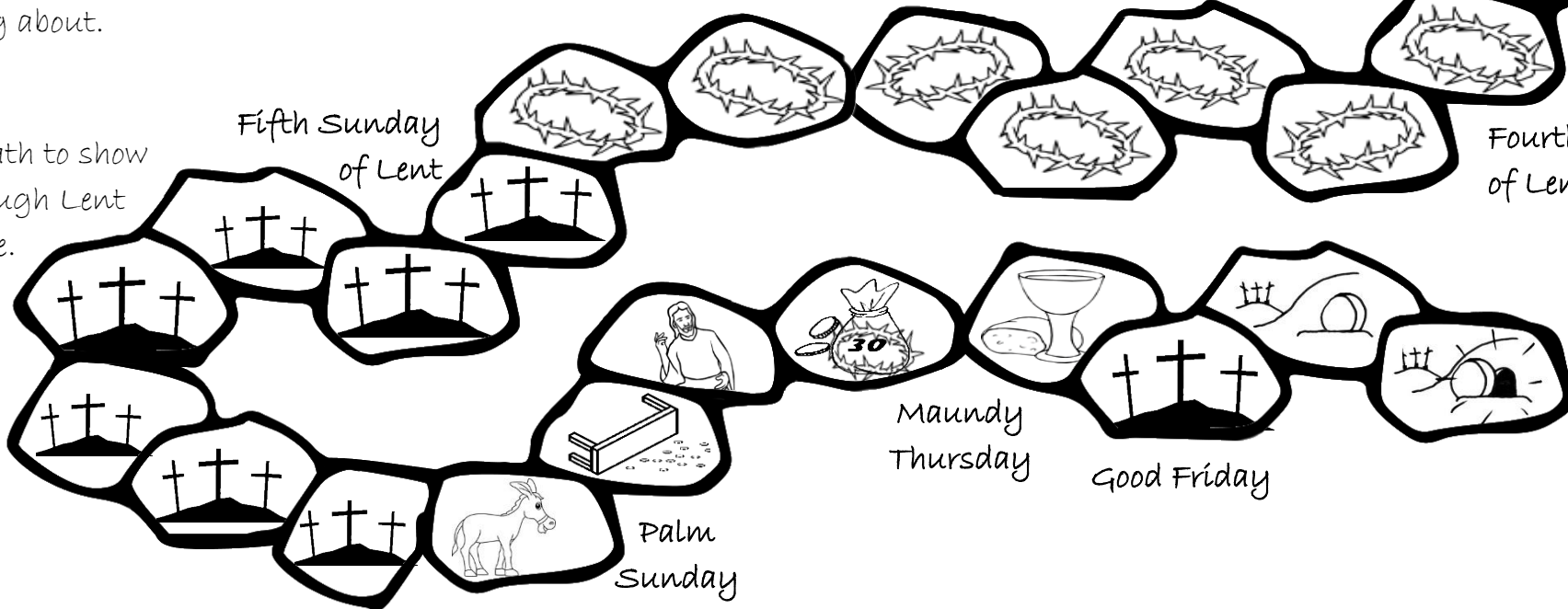
Third Sunday of Lent
