**LENT STUDY COURSE** - The next meetings of our Lent Study course will be on-:

- Tuesday 9th March 2.30pm-3.30pm or
- Wednesday 10th March 7.00pm-8.00pm

This year's course is based on the Bloomsbury Lent Book for 2021 '*Thy Will Be Done*' by Stephen Cherry, Dean of King's College, Cambridge. The book takes an in-depth look at the Lord's Prayer and uses six key words from the prayer as themes for reflection: Heaven, Earth, Bread, Temptation, Forgiveness, Glory. The sessions will include space for reflection, prayer and conversation based on the short chapters in each of these topic areas. Our next session will reflect on the phrase 'Give us this day our daily bread'. It is not too late to join the course. Everyone is very welcome!

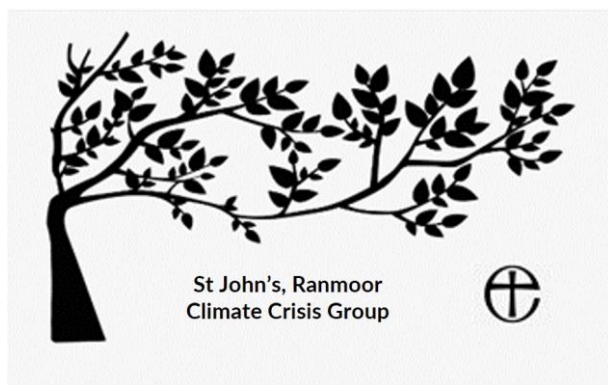

## Every Alternate Wednesday St John's Church, Ranmoor

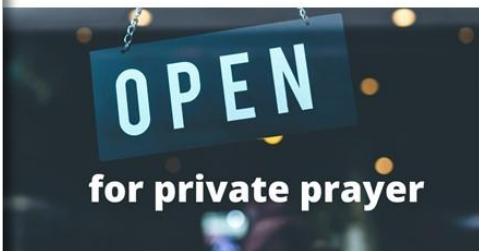
Please bring your foodbank items to Church on the following alternate Wednesdays between 10am and 12noon:
