LENT STUDY COURSE - The next meetings of our Lent Study course will be on-:

This year's course is based on the Bloomsbury Lent Book for 2021 '*Thy Will Be Done*' by Stephen Cherry, Dean of King's College, Cambridge. The book takes an indepth look at the Lord's Prayer and uses six key words from the prayer as themes for reflection: Heaven, Earth, Bread, Temptation, Forgiveness, Glory. The sessions will include space for reflection, prayer and conversation based on the short chapters in each of these topic areas.
