CHURCH BUILDING POST COVID GUIDANCE - now that we are in stage 4 of the recovery plan, we have revised our guidelines for the church. 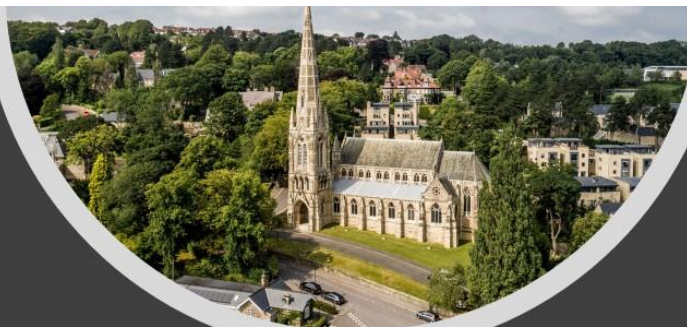
Lunch Club - The lunch club started back on **Wednesday 22nd September.**
