
COP 26. COP is an international climate summit. Every year, world ERENCE leaders gather to discuss climate change at COP, which stands for Conference of the Parties. Since 1995, the United Nations has

brought together 190 countries to agree on how to tackle climate change. This year is the 26th meeting, hence the name: COP26. The UK is hosting the summit which will take place in Glasgow, Scotland. It's the first time the UK has hosted COP, which was supposed to happen last year but had to be postponed because of COVID-19. As time runs out to turn back the clocks, COP26 is a critical opportunity to take meaningful action to tackle reducing global emissions and support countries who are already experiencing the worst impacts of climate change. St Marks Broomhill are holding a service at 7 PM next Sunday, 24th of October and this is an opportunity for us to focus on and pray together for COP26 quietly and reflectively. It will be encouraging to have a good number of people coming together to pray specifically for this momentous meeting.
