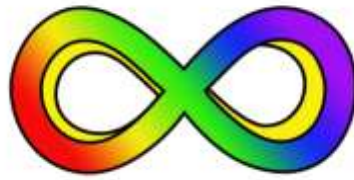

NOTICES

CHURCH BUILDING COVID GUIDANCE - Facemasks are not a legal requirement and are therefore optional. We have removed specified areas of socially distanced seating, but the side aisles tend to be quieter, so do sit there if you'd prefer more space. Sanitiser is readily available around the building. HOLY COMMUNION - From 8th January, those receiving Communion will be able to drink from the common cup but there is no compulsion to do so. Communicants can just receive bread if they wish and this is still a valid Communion.

TO MARK THE CORONATION OF HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III, the PCC has agreed to commission a new set of white vestments for the church. The PCC will underwrite the cost but if anyone would like to contribute to this project, please speak to Matthew or Alison.

LENT GROUPS - This year's Lent course is called Act Now! and will be shared across our mission partnership and the Manor Parish. We will be looking together at five moments in the life of the earliest church and asking how God shaped, is shaping and will shape the life of God's people. - 9.00pm and Thursday afternoons 2.30 - 4.00pm. Both courses will be held in the Parish Centre. The courses comprise five sessions, which start in the week commencing Monday 27th February.
