ADVENT STUDY GROUP – This year we are running a study group during Advent. We shall be meeting on three Thursday evenings in Advent, on 30th November, 7th December and 14th December. The group will meet in rooms 1 & 2 in the Parish Centre. The meetings will start at 7.30pm and refreshments will be available. The Study group will reflect on the seven 'O' Antiphons, which will be sung at our Advent Service on Sunday 3rd December at 6.30pm. Our study will be based on seven paintings in Jane Williams' book "The Art of Advent". Jane Williams is a well respected theologian and professor of Christian theology at St Mellitus College, London. The evenings will be led by Rev. Peter Das and Sandra Green. You will be welcome at any of the study sessions even if you have other commitments on some weeks. MISSION AREA POSADA - Posada is a Mexican Advent celebration in which two young people dressed as Mary and Joseph travel from house to house to proclaim the imminent arrival of Jesus and request that the newborn baby be given a room. This idea has been adapted so that nativity figures travel from place to place, staying in different homes throughout the Mission Area. Over three weeks, the figures will travel round the parishes of St Mark's (Wk1), St John's Ranmoor (Wk2) and St Marys Walkley (Wk3). You are invited to share hospitality with the people who bring the figures to you, maybe some food and drink, conversation, carols or prayers. The following day you take or give the figures to the next person on the list. But how you do this is up to you - feel free to improvise! If you can, please take photos during the time Mary and Joseph are with you and send them to the church office or Facebook page.
