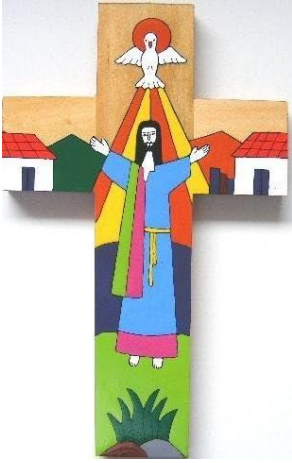

LENT 2024 - We shall now be running one Study Group during Lent. This will be on a Thursday afternoon from 2.30 - 4.00 pm in the Parish Centre. We shall be using Tom Wright's book 'Lent and Easter for Everyone - From wilderness to glory' by Tom Wright. (ISBN 978-0281-07141-8). Tom Wright is a very well-respected theologian and author and former Bishop of Durham. The book has seven weeks of daily readings and reflections. These can be used as the basis for individual reading and prayer during Lent and the Easter season and we will focus on selected readings for our Lent Groups. Relevant material will be provided for each of the study groups so you can still participate if you have not purchased the book. Each week the material will be self supporting, so you don't need to attend all the sessions. There is a sign-up sheet at the back of church. 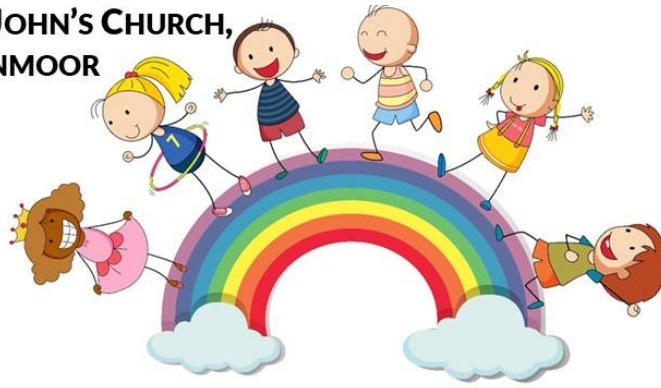

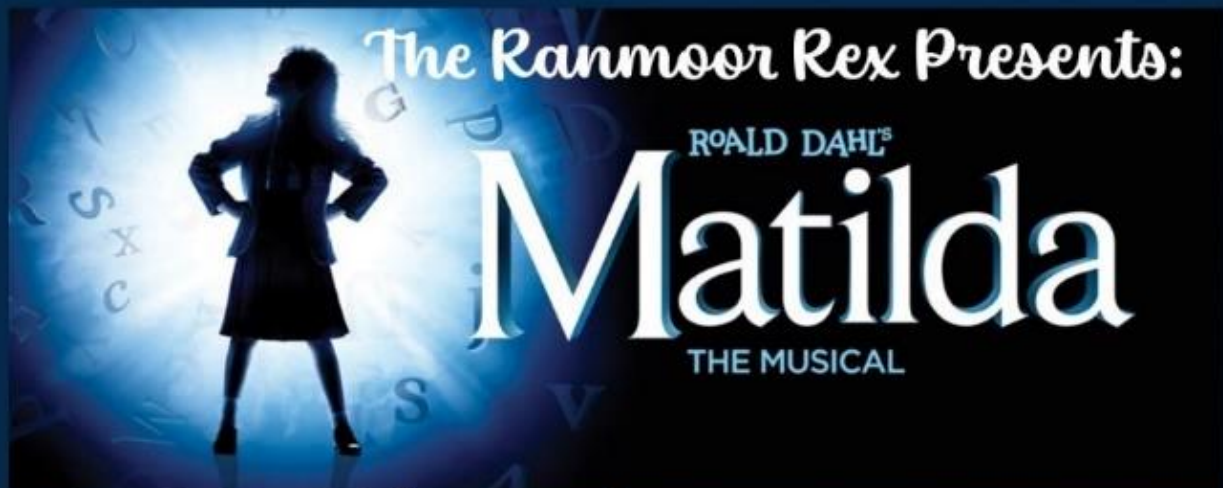
