# The Sacred Stones exhibition opens this week.

Margaret Bennett's beautiful paintings are inspired by stone: in churches and in the Peak District. Margaret is generously giving all the sales of her

paintings and greetings cards to the Inspire project to help us protect the fabric of this church. The exhibition will run from Saturday 15th June to **Saturday 29th June.** The church will be open from 3-6pm Tuesday to Friday and 10-4pm on Saturday 29th. At 2pm on Saturday 29th our children's worker Claire Eaton will be running a clay workshop, making mason's marks. Throughout the two weeks you will be able to see the video of the masons' marks in our church roof. This has been made by Brendan Sloan and James Stone, under the guidance of Mark Gregory. The church will also be open by appointment to neighbouring schools on Monday 17th and Monday 24th. Sacred Stones concert: On Saturday 15th at 5.30pm, the Lord Mayor will launch the exhibition followed by a concert by St John's Choir celebrating sacred buildings.
