### **The Sacred Stones exhibition**

Margaret Bennett's beautiful paintings are inspired by stone: in churches and in the Peak District. Margaret is generously giving all the sales of her paintings and greetings cards to the Inspire project to help us protect the fabric of this church. The exhibition runs from **Saturday** 

**15th June to Saturday 29th June.** The church will be open from 3-6pm Tuesday to Friday and 10-4pm on Saturday 29th. At 2pm on Saturday 29th our children's worker Claire Eaton will be running a clay workshop, making mason's marks. Throughout the two weeks you will be able to see the video of the masons' marks in our church roof. This has been made by Brendan Sloan and James Stone, under the guidance of Mark Gregory.

#### Making your Mark Children's Workshop

At 2pm there is a craft workshop, led by trained children's workers and artists. Like the stone masons who carved their personal signs, initials or even full names in the roof of our church, your children will have the opportunity of creating their own 'marks' on tablets of clay. They will also be able to create their own Green Man. Green Men were images of wild woodland creatures, hidden by medieval masons in the foliage they carved throughout England's churches. Find the Green Man created by our Victorian masons.
