We will be hiring scores of all three works and these will be available for participants to borrow on the day in exchange for a small fee (tbc but will be just to cover our cost of hiring that copy so probably around £1 per copy). Please let us know whether or not you will want to borrow either or both scores.

All the solo parts in the Duruflé will be sung by members of the choir of St John's.

The evening performance will be a full concert performance so please do encourage friends, relatives, neighbours, work colleagues etc. to come and listen, tickets priced £10 (under 18s free) will be available on the door.

## Notes:

Tea and coffee will be available throughout the day. We have left long enough gaps for people to get down to Broomhill (about a 15-minute walk) or elsewhere for lunch and supper but you are most welcome to bring sandwiches etc. and hang around at the church during those times.

Between the afternoon rehearsal and the concert, we can use the Parish Centre (just across the road from the church) for changing and generally making ourselves at home.

## Getting here:

St John's is just off Fulwood Road, about a mile and a half up the road from Weston Park Museum.

There is some unrestricted on-street parking up the road from church but most of the parking immediately outside is restricted to 4 hours. We also have a small amount of parking in front of the church on our drive but please can we restrict that to people with limited mobility.

If coming by public transport, St John's is a two-minute walk from the bus stop for the 120 on Fulwood road or a ten-minute walk from a bus stop for the 256 on Manchester Road.
