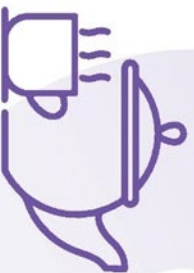

Church open to visitors from 2.00

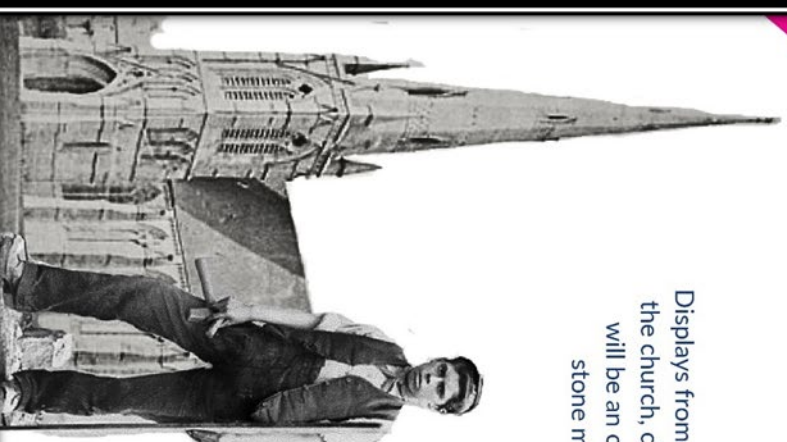
Talk begins at 5.30
