St John's runs a very active music programme with two choral services every Sunday and Choral Evensong every other Wednesday sung by various combinations of our Junior Choir, Choristers, Choral Scholars and Adult Choir. There is an honorarium of up to £1200 per year and there is also the possibility of organ lessons or other tuition where appropriate.
