DECORATING THE CHURCH FOR HARVEST FESTIVAL - We will be decorating the church with flowers for Harvest on Saturday 28th September from 9.45am – 11.45am. We usually make arrangements for the window sills, the font, the church porch and two pedestals at the front of church, so we need lots of arrangers! The theme for harvest this year is based on 'The parable of the weeds'. We will be completing arrangements on the windowsills in large glass jars (which we will supply) with autumnal colours incorporating foliage, autumn flowers (and hopefully some wild flowers if still around) seedheads, berries and fruits on the windowsills. We will provide a tied bunch of corn for the centre of the arrangement. We are hoping to achieve an informal effect - think cornfields & hedgerows! Please start saving your seedheads for us to use for harvest. It would be wonderful to recruit some more people to help us with the flowers. If you are new to flower arranging and are interested in learning we are a very friendly group of people and we'd gladly give you help and encouragement on the day or perhaps you might like to just come along and watch the arrangements take shape!
