Church open from 2pm, talk at 5.30pm


Late Victorian Ranmoor was home to an extraordinarily diverse group of people. Using the 1891 pew rental map of St John's, census returns for that year and newspaper reports, our research team is exploring who these individuals were and how they were connected to one another.

Sue Roe and Mary Grover from the Scissors Paper Stone project will share something of what they, Val Hewson and Jenny Stephenson have learned so far.
