- 1 Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of His holiness.
- 2 Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth, is mount Zion, on the sides of the north, the city of the great King.
- 3 God hath made Himself known in her palaces for a refuge.
- 4 For lo! the kings assembled themselves, they passed by together;
- 5 they saw, then were they amazed; they were dismay'd, they hasted away;
- 6 trembling took hold of them there, pain as of a woman in travail,
- 7 as with the east wind that breaketh the ships of Tarshish.
- 8 As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the Lord of hosts, in the city of our God: God will establish it for ever.
- 9 We have thought on thy loving kindness, O God, in the midst of Thy temple:
- 10 as is thy name, O God, so is Thy praise unto the ends of the earth; Thy right hand is full of righteousness.
- 11 Let mount Zion be glad, because of Thy judgements, let the daughters of Judah rejoice;
- 12 walk about Zion and go round about her, tell the towers thereof, mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces, that ye may tell it to the generation following.
- 13 For this God is our God for ever and ever; He will be our guide even unto death. Amen.
