

St John's, Ranmoor has had a thriving musical tradition since the church's consecration in 1879. Our Choristers (aged 8-14), Junior Choir (aged 5-8) and Choral Scholars (aged 13-18) are at the centre of everything we do. We are very proud of them and of being able to maintain this tradition, ably supported by a team of dedicated and hugely talented volunteer adult singers.

Our younger singers play a vital part in providing the high-quality music which supports the worship in St John's and they benefit from high quality musical training and from the confidence that comes from performing regularly to a high standard.

It costs around £50,000 per year to fully fund a music scheme on the scale of ours at St John's. We are fortunate to have the support of the church's congregation and PCC and between that, fundraising efforts and support in kind given by volunteers we are able to maintain an excellent standard of singing and an ambitious programme of music-making.
